The PennHIP method of canine hip evaluation utilizes a special distraction device and depends on precise positioning of the patient to obtain diagnostic radiographs. Only "certified" PennHIP members can take and submit radiographs for official analysis. Certified members have successfully completed quality assurance exercises at their respective practices to ensure consistency and accuracy in performing the PennHIP radiographic technique. A distraction device is required to perform PennHIP radiography and can be purchased through PennHIP. A one-time reading fee is charged for the quality assurance exercises (see fee schedule below). Although these fees are optional, we suggest that registrants pay for them with registration so that the distractor will be delivered to the seminar and certification exercises may be started immediately upon return to your clinic.
