

PennHIP Submitting Digital Images

At this time, we are unable to accept digital images via the internet. We are fervently working on a solution to this problem and anticipate a solution in the near future. You can, however, still submit digital radiographs to PennHIP for evaluation. To send us your digital images, use the following “low-tech” method .

All images must be in **DICOM** (Digital Imaging and **C**ommunications in **M**edicine) format. DICOM image files have a “.dcm” file extension. We cannot accept any other format (no JPEG, GIF, TIFF, etc.). Save the hip-extended, compression and distraction views onto a CD, and mail it **along with the Radiograph Evaluation Application**, to the PennHIP Administrative Center (NOTE: Do not send to Analysis Center).
